SUBJECT: Accepting Applications for the Social Services Transportation Advisory Council

For those interested, attached is an application for appointment to the Social Services Transportation Advisory Council (SSTAC). The SSTAC consists of representatives of various groups and social service organizations plus members of the public in Nevada County who volunteer their time to participate on an advisory council to the Nevada County Transportation Commission (NCTC) regarding transit and paratransit issues in Nevada County. There are positions open for a representative of potential transit users for individuals with disabilities and a representative of the Hispanic community in the Truckee area. Members of the SSTAC are appointed by the NCTC and serve a three-year term. The SSTAC meets approximately three to four times annually.

A summary of the responsibilities of the SSTAC are provided below:

- Annually participate in the identification of transit needs.
- Advise the NCTC of any other major transit issues.
- Provide input on transit planning studies.
