The Nevada County Transportation Commission is sponsoring transportation workshops for Nevada County organizations and individuals. Project planners are inviting organizations and individuals to provide input of the draft strategies and prioritization of the proposed solutions for addressing the identified public transportation needs and opportunities for coordination. The workshops are being held to assist the development of the Nevada County Public Transportation - Human Services Coordination Plan. The Plan's goal is to improve mobility for county residents through public input and coordination of services among transportation providers and human service agencies in Nevada County.

Projects submitted for certain types of Federal Transit Administration (FTA) grant programs are required to be derived from a Human Service-Public Transportation Coordination Plan. Projects included in the plan could be eligible for the following federal grant programs: FTA Section 5311 Rural Area Formula Grants and FTA Section 5310 Elderly and Disabled Transportation Assistance Program. These funding sources can be used for operating assistance for existing or new transit/paratransit services, replace buses or purchase new equipment like bus shelters or dispatch software.
