SUBJECT: Request for Proposal (RFP) to Prepare Senate Bill 743 Vehicle Miles Traveled (VMT) Methodology and Threshold Recommendations

DATE: November 10, 2017

Attached is a RFP to prepare VMT methodology and threshold recommendations in relation to California Senate Bill 743, which changed how transportation impacts are to be measured under the California Environmental Quality Act.

Proposals are to be submitted to the Nevada County Transportation Commission (NCTC) on or before Friday, December 8, 2017 by 5:00 p.m. Consultants need to deliver six (6) bound copies of the proposal and an electronic copy on a USB flash drive to the Nevada County Transportation Commission, 101 Providence Mine Road, Suite 102, Nevada City, CA 95959. Late proposals will not be accepted. Oral interviews are tentatively scheduled for Tuesday, December 19, 2017, should it be determined they are needed. A complete schedule of activities is included in the text of the RFP. Also attached is a sample contract similar to NCTC's Professional Services Agreement that the selected consultant would be required to execute.

The NCTC reserves the right to negotiate with bidders on all aspects of the proposed work or to reject all proposals and reissue the RFP or withdraw the RFP at any time without prior notice. The NCTC is an equal opportunity employer, and women and minority owned businesses (DBEs) are encouraged to apply.

The NCTC also advises that participation of DBEs is not a condition of award.
