SUBJECT: Amend the Nevada County Pedestrian Improvement Plan to Include Nevada County's Planned Sidewalk Extension Project on Nevada City Highway



**RECOMMENDATION:** Adopt Resolution 14-21.

**BACKGROUND:** Nevada County Public Works has requested that NCTC amend the Nevada County Pedestrian Improvement Plan to include the proposed construction of a sidewalk along Nevada City Highway between Banner Lava Cap Road and Skewes Lane. This proposed project will create a continuous sidewalk between the Seven Hills Business District and the Brunswick Basin. Amending the requested project into the Nevada County Pedestrian Improvement Plan will identify the project as part of the planned network of pedestrian facilities and make the project more competitive for grant funding opportunities.



Provide sidewalk improvements and pedestrian refuge islands on Ridge Road in front of Nevada Union High School (shares County right-of-way)	
Provide sidewalks on Nevada City Highway between Banner Lava Cap Road and Skewes Lane - <u>Amended into Table 5 on July 16, 2014. Source: NCTC/Nevada County</u>	
<b>Tier 2</b>	
Provide sidewalks on McCourtney Road between Brighton Street and west side of Nevada County Fairgrounds, including widening of existing sidewalk and crosswalk improvements (coordinate with City of Grass Valley)	
Provide sidewalks on West Main Street between Gilmore Way and Squirrel Creek Road	
Provide sidewalks on Squirrel Creek Road between West main Street and Cedar Avenue

RESOLUTION AMENDING THE NEVADA COUNTY PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENT PLAN TO INCLUDE NEVADA COUNTY'S PLANNED SIDEWALK EXTENSION PROJECT ALONG NEVADA CITY HIGHWAY FROM BANNER LAVA CAP ROAD TO SKEWES LANE

WHEREAS, the Nevada County Transportation Commission (NCTC) is the designated Regional Transportation Planning Agency (RTPA) for Nevada County, created pursuant to Title 7.88, of the State of California Government Code, Section 67920; and

WHEREAS, the NCTC is responsible for incorporation of all transportation modes into the Regional Transportation Planning process; and

WHEREAS, the Nevada County Pedestrian Improvement Plan, adopted March 16, 2011, is a planning guide for jurisdictions in Nevada County for the development of pedestrian infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, Nevada County Public Works has requested NCTC amend the Nevada County Pedestrian Improvement Plan to include the proposed construction of a sidewalk along Nevada City Highway between Banner Lava Cap Road and Skewes Lane; and

WHEREAS, amending the requested project into the Nevada County Pedestrian Improvement Plan will identify this project as part of the planned network of pedestrian facilities and enhance funding opportunities.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Nevada County Transportation Commission hereby adds Nevada County's planned sidewalk extension project on Nevada City Highway to Table 5, Tier 1 and Figure 3B of the Nevada County Pedestrian Improvement Plan.


